Spring Clean Up

Spring clean up will be May 17th & 18th and May 24th & 25th. No regular garbage collection will take place during these designated clean up days. Residents are advised that garbage must be placed as close to the road as possible without creating interference with street traffic. Residents are also asked not to place garbage out before the designated dates. The final day of clean up is May 25th and all garbage must be out by 9:00 a.m. Absolutely no grass, trees, tires, batteries, etc.

Boil Water Advisory's (BWO)

We would like to advise all residents to check the former Town Office door or the Post Office periodically for a BWO. While we try to contact everyone when we have to place a boil water advisory sometimes someone may get missed or not be in Trinity when the BWO is issued. We especially ask this of our seasonal residents and operators of B & B's as you may come to Trinity during a weekend or evening and not get the notification until later.

Municipal Awareness Day

May 18th, is Municipal Awareness Day and we are asking residents to join us in a community clean up. We will meet in the playground area in Trinity at 9:00 a.m. and start cleaning up our playground area and community garbage boxes/cans then proceed around Trinity and on to Goose Cove. Garbage bags and gloves will be provided. Let's everyone pull together and make our community clean and tidy.

Lunch will be provided for residents who participate (A & K Catering will be serving sandwiches and tea/coffee).

Compost Bins

The Trinity Festival Committee has purchased 50 compost bins that will be sold for \$30.00 each. In the near future we will be offering an information session on how to get the best results from your composting bin and how to maintain them properly.
