Fire Ban

As per provincial regulations as of April 21, 2020 there is now an Open Fire Ban in effect for the entire province and will remain in effect until September 30,2020. This includes setting open fires on forest land or within 300 meters of forest land; a ban on grass burning, brush burning, campfires and personal fireworks. Gas BBQs and CSA approved patio wood burning devices including enclosed fire pits are excluded from the ban.
